This year's Waterloo 2026 exhibition theme is 'Now I make a leaf of voices' celebrating polyphony and plurality as the foundation of the creative expression. This theme is shared with the Waterloo Festival 2026, and can take the shape of personal and communal voices, inspired by emotions, histories, opinions.

The London Group members will be invited in an Open Call at the end of March to participate with artworks suitable to be placed outdoors, surviving the weather conditions, for the period of 2 months (July & Aug) and are meant to integrate with the garden locations of St John's in a meaningful way. To increase the impact and resonance of the exhibition, this year we are planning to extend the invitation to participate in one invited non-member artist per participating member (you can invite if you commit to participate). More information and detailed requirements will be communicated at the Open Call at the end of March.

Following the successful poetry & workshop events from last year, we are encouraging the participating London Group members to think and propose ideas for public engagement events with the local community groups (related to the work they plan to bring or their art practice and the theme). ITALY

The Personal Relations Exhibition in Este (Italy) will take place from the 23rd of May until the 7th of June. The opening event will be on Saturday 23rd of May 2026, at 6pm. We are also organising an informal meet and greet for the artists / artist talks on Sunday 24th (exact time tbc).

The exhibition will take place at the Ex-Chiesetta dell'Annunziata - a former small chapel converted into a modern art space at the heart of Este, directly on a piazza with shops and cafes. Este is a small medieval town south of Padova and near Venice, where there will also be the Venice Biennale at the same time. If you haven't been there before, both Venice and Padova are worth a visit when you come to the Personal Relations Exhibition in Este.
